## SECTION 17.0300 FEES AND PENALTIES

## 17.0301 PERMIT FEES

All persons, firms, or corporations performing work which by this Ordinance requires the issuance of a permit shall pay a fee for such permit to the Village to help defray the cost of administration, investigation, advertising, and processing of permits and variances. The permits for which a fee is required are the Building Permit, Occupancy Permit, Conditional Use Permit, Land Disturbing Permit, Sign Permit, Fence Permit, Satellite Dish Antenna Permit, and Accessory Structure Permit. A fee shall also be required for a zoning text or map amendment, and a zoning appeal or variance. All fees shall be established by separate resolution by the Village Board from time to time as deemed appropriate.

## 17.0302 VIOLATIONS

It shall be unlawful to construct or use any structure, land, or water in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance. Failure to secure the necessary permits prior to commencing construction shall also constitute a violation. In case of any violation, the Village Board, the Administrator, the Plan Commission, or any property owner who would be specifically damaged by such violation may institute appropriate action or proceedings to enjoin a violation of this Ordinance.

## 17.0303 PENALTIES

Any person, firm, or corporation that fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) and costs of prosecution for each violation, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment thereof, but not exceeding 30 days. Any person, firm or corporation that fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance for a second or subsequent violations, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) and the costs of prosecution for each violation, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until payment thereof, but not exceeding 60 days. Each day a violation exists or continues shall constitute a separate offense, except that in order for the defendant to be charged with a second offense it shall be a separate and distinct violation as opposed to a continuing daily violation on the same provision.
