As spring draws near, we hope everyone is anticipating sunnier days, warmer temperatures, and all that comes with the season. This winter, the Village of Sussex has enjoyed many memorable events. Be sure to visit the Village website and follow our social media pages to stay informed about the exciting activities and events planned throughout the year.

Work continues in Village Park on the new Park Maintenance Shop and The Ridge, our new pavilion, and both projects are moving along on schedule.

We've also kicked off design work for the 2027 Road Program. Planned improvements will focus mainly on areas north of the Corporate Center and the Village of Lisbon limits, south of the Union Pacific railroad tracks, east of STH 164, and west of Maple Avenue, including the Bowling Green Estates, Sussex Estates, Crestview, Stone Ridge Estates, Eagles Ridge, and Sussex Preserve subdivisions.

In addition, a citizen committee has begun meeting to discuss Phase C of the Village Park Master Plan, which looks ahead to a potential five-field ball diamond complex in Village Park. Committee members will continue working with our architects to shape the design and consider the needs and interests of our community groups.

On behalf of the Village Board, thank you for your continued support and involvement in our community. The progress we've made, and the work still to come, reflects our shared commitment to keeping Sussex a vibrant and welcoming place for all. I encourage residents to attend our public meetings to stay informed about the projects, priorities, and work taking place throughout the Village. Your involvement and feedback are always welcome and appreciated.
